MATHEMATICS

2. During travelling you observe the different kinds of sign boards, geometrical pictures etc. Observe them carefully and draw any six pictures on A4 size sheet where you find the parallel and intersecting lines. Mention corresponding, vertically opposite, alternate interior and linear pair angles.

2. ANALYSING MOTION

Plan to go to a place by vehicle with your parents. Take readings of odometer and speedometer after every 5 minutes till you reach your destination. Record these observations in tabular form; plot graphs between Distance-Time and Speed-Time. State whether this motion is uniform or non-uniform motion. Write the complete procedure in practical sheets and click pictures while performing the activity.

3. INVISIBLE INK USING BAKING SODA AND GRAPE JUICE

Title: Secret messages with invisible ink.

Use the chemical reaction between a base (baking soda) and an acid/indicator (grape juice) to reveal hidden text.

Create a report titled "**The Secret Agent Chronicles.**"

- You have to describe what happened when the grape juice was applied.
- What colour did the ink turn into?
- Explain why the message appeared. Paste the "revealed" secret message paper on an A4 size sheet.

SOCIAL SCIENCE

1. Maintain a weather diary for 7 days. Record temperature, rainfall, humidity, and wind conditions (you can use a weather app or news report). Present your data in a table/chart on A4 size sheet.

2. "Create Your Own Election Poster" on A3 size sheet.
